

ANYWHERE MAP® ANNOUNCES THE 100LL.COM™ FLIGHT DATA ACCESS CARD!

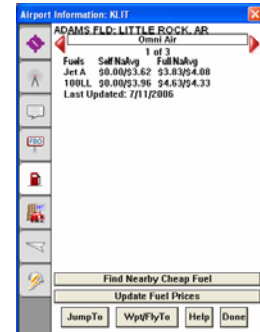
Pittsburg, KS – Fuel prices continue to soar and finding the best deal is no longer incidental to the flight. To many people you either save some bucks on fuel or you don't go. Anywhere Map introduces the Flight Data Access Card, a unique and exclusive service from Anywhere Map and 100LL.COM that can save ANYONE big bucks on fuel purchases. And it's as simple and close as using your cell phone!



Anywhere Map has operated the website 100LL.COM since 2005 and it is now considered the most consistently accurate fuel price source on the Internet. The prices are updated on a 14-21 day rotation and the site also includes FBO services with nearby accommodations.



Anyone can access the data on 100LL.COM on the Internet for no charge. But many times the requirement to make fuel stop decisions does not occur when you're in front of a computer. Anywhere Map customers can upload the data from 100LL.COM into their Anywhere Map systems and actually make fuel stop decisions while enroute! No other system offers this capability.



But the problem still remains for those unable to access the Internet and who are not [yet] Anywhere Map customers that they can not get fuel prices quickly for their route. The Flight Data Access Card allows anyone to access data from the 100LL.COM website using the text messaging function of their cell phones. Simply text the airport identifiers in which you're interested (ex: KJLN KICT) to FDAC@100LL.COM. In a few minutes you'll get a text message back that contains the fuel prices for the airport(s) requested plus nearby fuel prices plus nearby cheaper fuel. You'll also get current METAR data for the airports you requested. So you keep tabs on the route weather AND check fuel prices before you launch.

“We saved over \$115 on our last trip by picking an airport that was only 20 miles distant from our planned fuel stop,” says Jay Humbard, President and CEO of Control Vision Corp. “The FDAC is the first service of its type in aviation. Text messaging is so simple and available to nearly anyone with a cell phone. So instead of taking your chances and just paying the price, use the FDAC to get fuel prices at and near your intended fuel stop. You could save twice or three times the annual subscription fee in one stop!”

Flight Data Access Cards are available directly from Anywhere Map and can be purchased in 12, 6, and 3 month subscriptions for \$50, \$30, and \$20 respectively.
