

## **ANYWHERE TAXI-EXPRESS™ SHOWS AIRCRAFT POSITION DURING TAXI OPERATIONS**

Control Vision Corp., makers of award-winning Anywhere Map, Anywhere Wx, and Pocket Plates has added a significant feature to its moving map products that should result in a chorus of grateful pilots.

**Anywhere Taxi-Express™** is based on accurate airport diagrams derived from current NACO approach plates. Anywhere Map displays these in North-Up format with a virtual aircraft indicating the current GPS position. The diagrams display all published runways, paved and turf, as well as taxiways and buildings.

Control Vision President and CEO Jay Humbard explained, “Pilots landing at unfamiliar airports are often confused by the maze of taxiways and signs posted, especially at night. Controllers may give rapid-fire instructions to landing and departing aircraft, the first priority being to clear the active runway for incoming aircraft.”

“Pilots fortunate enough to be at a controlled airport can request ‘Progressive Taxi’ instructions,” he said. “**Anywhere Taxi-Express** answers the need for an easily displayed, accurate airport diagram that shows pilots real-time GPS position and direction of travel.”



By using modern 12-channel GPS receivers that are accurate to within 10 meters or better on the ground, the product accurately displays direction of travel when marginal movement is detected.

**Taxi-Express** Airport Diagrams contain embedded geo-referencing data that the program treats as a moving map. The airport diagram is presented as part of Anywhere Map’s Airport Information suite containing runway and lighting data, radio frequencies, FBOs, hotels and an optional fuel price database.

FAA Safety Inspector Pete Acevedo tested Taxi-Express and commented, “A feature like this would definitely make a difference in runway incursions. This enhances one’s ability to follow the aircraft’s progress and respond accurately to directions. This is especially important at large complexes.”

**Anywhere Taxi-Express** is offered free to current Anywhere Map subscribers as part of the data subscription and covers most public airports in the continental US.
