

Taxi-Express™ displays an aircraft's GPS position on an airport diagram during taxi operations. This brings pilots an added measure of safety at airports they are unfamiliar with or during night operations. The Taxi-Express chart lets you monitor ground position while communicating with Tower and Ground as well as other aircraft. Taxi-Express charts are derived from FAA Terminal Procedures.

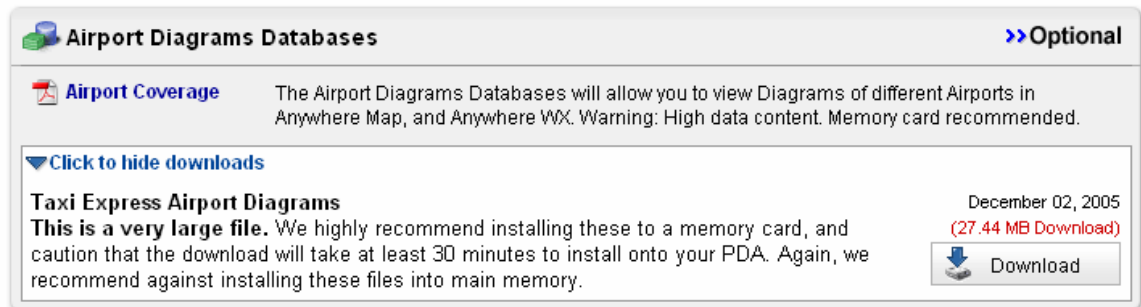
Taxi-Express is built into the **Airport Diagrams Database** file you download from the web.

Requirements

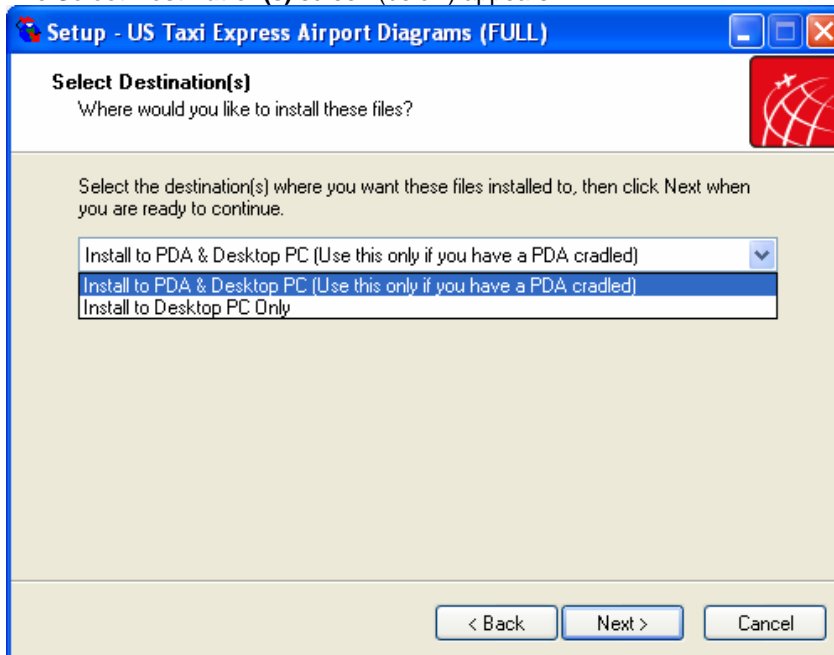
1. **Anywhere Map 1.7.1** or later or **Anywhere XP 1.6** or later
2. **Airport Diagrams Database** file;
3. **Memory Card** (SD or CF) 128 MB recommended (PDA installation)

Important: Installing on a PDA - You are going to download and install a **27 MB** file. **Be sure to install this on a memory card** and **NOT** in the PDA's main memory where it would use up a third of the available RAM which would slow the system noticeably.

1. Click on **Downloads** from the Anywhere Map home page. **Login** with your User Name and Password to go to the **Download Center**. Scroll down to your product (Anywhere Map, Anywhere Wx, Anywhere XP) and click on the product name.
2. In the next screen, scroll to **Airport Diagrams Databases** as shown below and click on the **Download** button on the right. When asked if you want to **Run** or **Save** this file, click **Run** to install it. The **Taxi Express Setup Wizard** appears. Click **Next>**.



3. The **Select Destination(s)** screen (below) appears.



Click on the drop-down arrow at right. If you are installing this to your PDA, select **Install to PDA & Desktop PC**. If installing to Anywhere XP, select **Install to Desktop PC Only**. Then tap **Next>**. The following window (Install to PDA) appears:

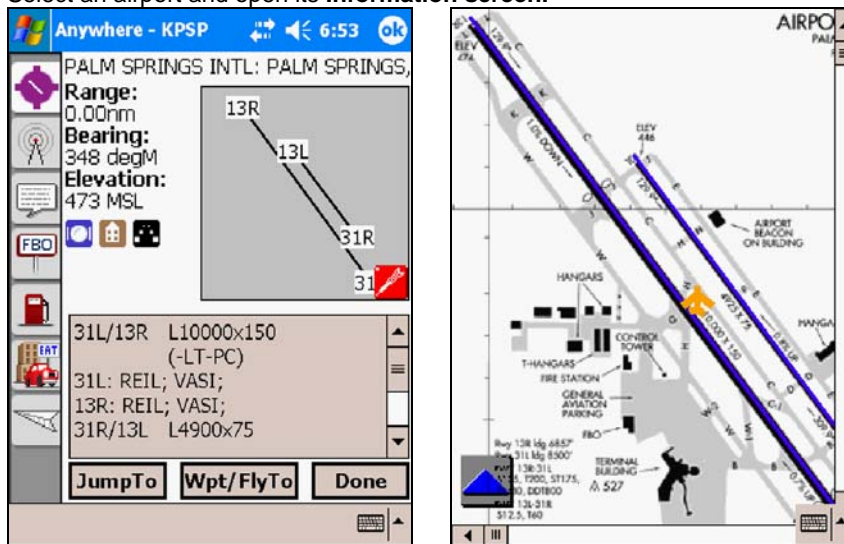
4. Click on **Removable Media** to complete the installation to the Memory Card. **Reminder:** Be sure **NOT** to install this file in the PDA's main memory.



USING TAXI-EXPRESS

The following instructions apply to **PDA-based** Anywhere Map or WX:

1. Select an airport and open its **Information** screen.



2. Double-tap the **runway diagram** on the opening screen.
3. If you have installed the **Airport Diagrams Database**, it will open to a rendering of the airfield showing runways, taxiways and buildings.

If bold blue lines are visible over the runways, the diagram has already been **calibrated** and will display your aircraft's GPS position. If the lines are not present or do not align with the runways, recalibrate this diagram.

4. **CALIBRATION:** Tap on the blue triangle at the lower left of the screen. You are instructed to tap on a runway end. Be sure to check the diagram to know which runway end you tapped. A list of runways appears. Select the correct runway. Back at the diagram, select another runway end. Repeat the ID process.
5. On completion, blue-highlighted lines will trace over the runways.
6. **Tap the blue triangle** and select **Close**.

- **IMPORTANT:** If the traced lines don't closely follow the centerlines of the runways, repeat the process. Don't click on an overrun area or a closed portion of a runway or a turf runway.
- **TROUBLESHOOTING:** I inadvertently installed the **Taxi Express Airport Diagrams database** in my PDA's main memory. What should I do?
Answer: The database has been installed (incorrectly) in a folder called **APDG** inside a folder called **DAT** in the device. Using **File Explorer** from your PDA tap on **My Device**. A list of folders appears. Tap on **DAT** folder to open it. Tap and hold on the **APDG** folder until a drop-down menu appears. Select (tap) **Cut** to remove the **APDG** folder and its contents. Tap **My Device**. When the list of folders appears, tap **SD Card**. In the next screen tap **DAT** to open this folder. (There are DAT folders in both the PDA's memory and the SD Card) Tap and hold in a clear space within the folder; select **Paste** from the drop-down menu. Restart your PDA. If you followed this procedure, the APDG folder and its contents has been moved from the PDA's memory to the Memory Card.

- When I double-tap an airport's runway diagram, the airport diagram that appears does not appear to be calibrated.
Answer: The Taxi Express Airport Diagrams database is pre-calibrated. Check that you are running version 1.71 or later of Anywhere Map or WX. Check the location of the APDG folder: it should be inside the DAT folder in the memory card. Be sure the memory card is seated. Start File Explorer to check if the card is recognized.
